- Undertake collateral duties as needed by the unit

- Professional-level mastery of your instrument
- Musical versatility; able to demonstrate multiple stylistic abilities
- Dynamic musician capable of blending into an ensemble, and standing out as a soloist
- Able to meet Army height, weight, and physical fitness standards
- Civilian applicants must be between 17-34 years of age; U.S citizen or other qualified resident

- Three contrasting selections demonstrating commercial and classical vocal capabilities:
  - One selection from Top 100 (Pop, Rock, R&B, Country, Jazz)
  - One contemporary musical theatre selection (Post-1970)
  - One Aria, Art Song, or golden age musical theatre selection (Pre-1970)
- The National Anthem, unaccompanied in the key of your choice


## **SALARY/BENEFITS**
